Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts may cause choking if swallowed.

Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

Check you have all the components and tools listed Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

> Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same area) as possible.

Do not place furniture directly in front of radiators, fires or any other source of heat.







The assembly will be easier with two people while one person could also do the job.

General care & maintenance

Using damp cloth and mild detergent for routine maintenance, do not use blench or abrasive cleaners.

From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

Clean & Sanitize Tips

Use this method for a quick clean-up here and there throughout the season — adding in the bleach solution to easily sanitize and eliminate any stubborn stains or dirt build-up from the winter months.

- Mix mild dish soap and warm water in a bucket.
- Use a clean cloth to wipe the soapy mixture onto the surfaces of your furniture, cleaning off any dirt.
- For extra cleaning power or to sanitize, mix 1/3 bleach and 2/3 water.
- Apply bleach mixture to furniture with a clean cloth and allow it to sit on the lumber for a few minutes (this will not affect the color).
- Loosen any dirt and debris that may catch in the surface grooves of the lumber by scrubbing the bleach mixture with a soft-bristle brush.
- Rinse thoroughly using a garden hose with a spray nozzle.






STEP 1

- Attach "Chair Legs (B/C)" to "Chair Seat Frame (A)" - Using "4 M6 × 60MM Bolrs&7 Washer& ®Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.
- Attach "Chair Arms (D/E)" to "Chair Legs (B/C)" - Using "4 M6 × 60MM Bolrs& 7 Washer& 8 Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.

(7) ×2

- Attach "Chair Back (F)" to "Chair Arms (D/E)" - Using "6 M6 × 70MM Bolts", tighten with screwdriver.
- Connect "Chair Back (F)" to "Chair Seat Frame (A)" with "Braces (I)" - Using "2 M6 × 40MM Bolts and ③ M6 × 50MM Bolts& ⑦ Washer& ®Nut", tighten with hex key and



- Attach "Front Stretcher (H)" to "Chair Legs (B/C)" - Using "① M5 × 40MM Screws", tighten with screwdriver.
- Attach "Back Stretcher(G)" to "Chair Seat Frame (A)" - Using "② M6 × 40MM Bolts", tighten with Hex key.
- Attach "Plugs (J)" to "Chair Legs (B/C)" - Using "⑤ M4 × 12MM Screws", tighten with screwdriver, then insert the "Plugs (J)" into the hole on "Chair Legs (B/C)".

Folding Chair

This Adirondack chair can be easily folded flat by pulling out the "Plugs (J)" inserted in the chair legs
